



Town of Freedom Seasonal Worker (Summer)

The Town of Freedom is accepting applications for a seasonal worker for the 2025 summer season. The nature of the work is primarily located in the parks and the individual will report to the DPW Foreman. Duties include grounds and facilities maintenance, mowing and trimming grass, painting, litter and trash pick-up, cleaning facilities, etc. Position is budgeted for up to 40 hours per week for 13 weeks from June-August. Weekend and holiday hours may be needed if necessary. Must be at least 16 years of age and possess a valid Wisconsin driver's license. Key Responsibilities:

- Operates equipment such as tractors, mowers, pickup trucks, weed eaters, leaf blowers, etc.
- Performs watering, weed control, litter pickup, and mulching of landscape areas.
- Plants and maintains shrubs, trees, ground covers, etc.
- Performs pruning, applying fertilizer, soil amendments, edging, building clean-up, and vandalism repairs.
- Assists with ball diamond and soccer field preparation work in accordance with town policies.
- Performs hand work, shovels, picks up litter, branches, debris, etc.
- Cleans and washes equipment, vehicles, and/or facilities.
- Completes and submits accurate record of time, location, materials, and equipment used on jobs.
- Follows all standard safety rules and guidelines established by but not limited to the town, county, state, and federal law.
- Will at times work independently and at times work with DPW crew members.
- Other duties may be assigned by DPW Foreman.
